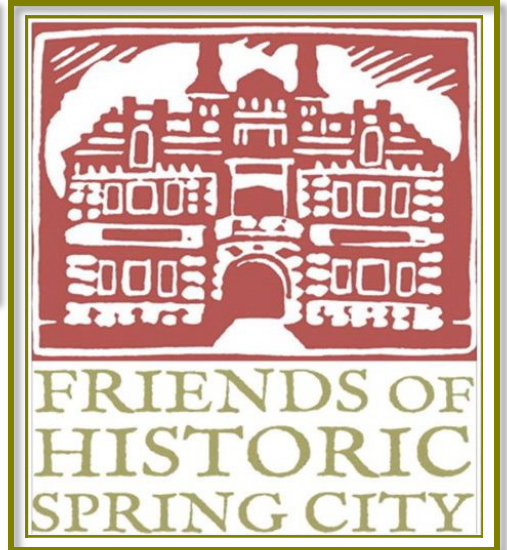

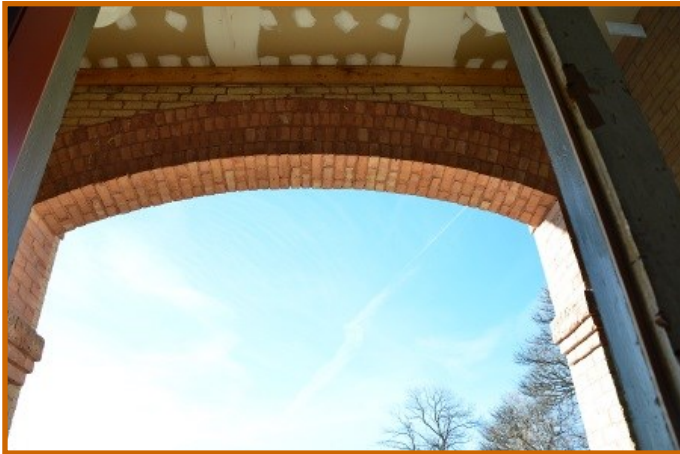
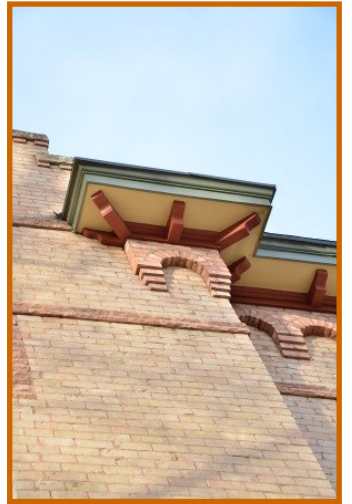
Old School Renovation Progress Photos

We are concluding the current stage of construction on the Old Spring City school & hope that many visitors will come to see the progress on Heritage Day. 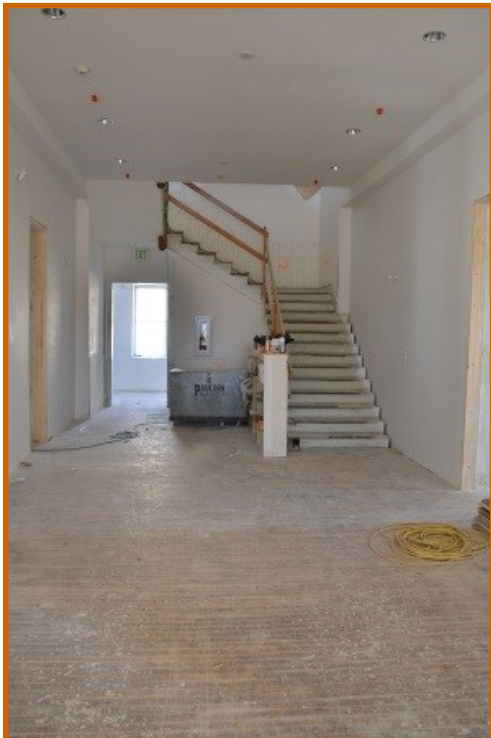

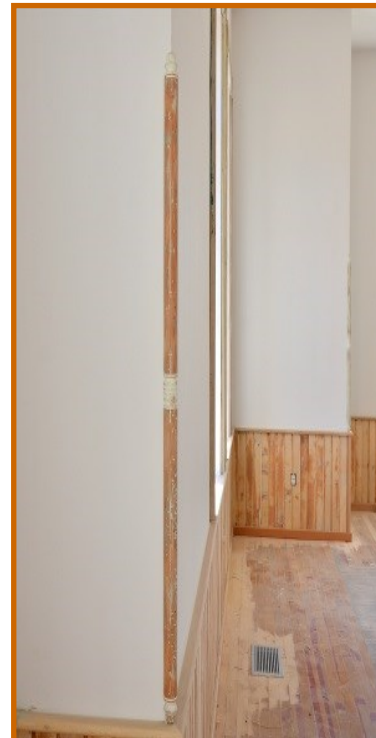
Main Floor—South East Room

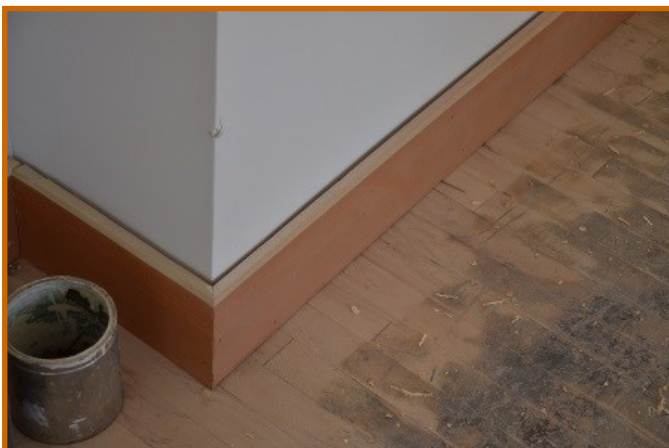

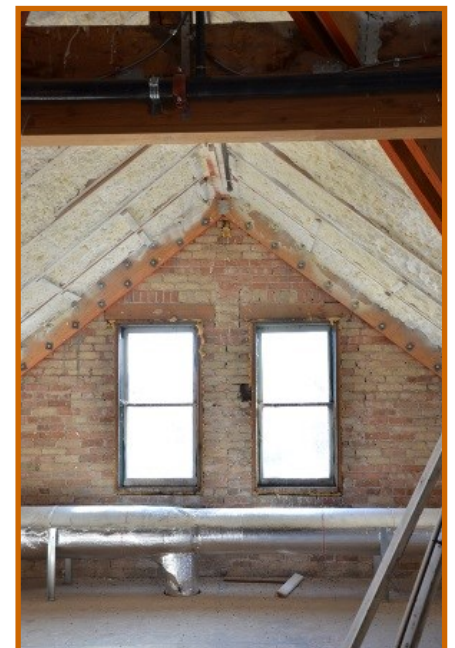
